Description

The 2.4G2 antibody reacts specifically with a common nonpolymorphic epitope on the extracellular domains of the mouse $Fc\gamma III$ and $Fc\gamma II$ receptors. It has also been reported to bind the $Fc\gamma I$ receptor (CD64) via its Fc domain. 2.4G2 mAb blocks non-antigen-specific binding of immunoglobulins to the $Fc\gamma III$ and $Fc\gamma II$, and possibly $Fc\gamma I$, receptors *in vitro* and *in vivo*. CD16 and/or CD32 are expressed on natural killer cells, monocytes, macrophages, dendritic cells (at low levels), Kupffer cells, granulocytes, mast cells, B lymphocytes, immature thymocytes, and some activated mature T lymphocytes.

Preparation and Storage

Store undiluted at 4°C.

The monoclonal antibody was purified from tissue culture supernatant or ascites by affinity chromatography.

This preparation contains no preservatives, thus it should be handled under aseptic conditions.
